


CONTRACTORS AND ENGINEERS IN THE **MIDWEST** STRUGGLING WITH JOB SITE DATA



A new survey found that manual data collection is plaguing job sites in the Midwest, leading to costs due to unsubstantiated claims and to identifying potential risks before they become big problems.

Only 14% can substantiate 80% or more claims with reports or other documentation, the lowest in the country

76% of executives said identifying potential issues before they become big problems is their biggest challenge, compared to the national average of 70%



These issues stem from manual data collection. **More than half (56%) of construction and engineering firms** in the Midwest claimed they still use manual processes, including pen and paper, compared to the rest of the country where only 44% claim to use manual methods.

THE BRIGHT SIDE FOR THE MIDWEST

Contractors and engineers in the Midwest lead the country in assembling managing data efficiently once it's collected.

43% of managers said work and change orders rarely get missed or lost. This stands out from the national average, where only 28% were able to say the same.

32% of executives said they spend less than an hour per day assembling data for reports, well above the rest of the country, where only 22% said the same.

This data is part of a **new national report** from TrackVia, which found manual data collection is leading to diminished work quality, project delays, compliance issues, and soaring costs.

Despite **74% of managers** saying that ensuring a high quality of work is the most important part of their job,



52% said they use manual methods to track job quality data



59% said this leads to incomplete data about work quality



61% of executives said they have to make decisions with outdated data



65% of managers said work and change orders get missed some to all of the time and slow down time-to-completion

Top three costs that managers say their businesses face from manual data entry:



76% said costs related work quality, especially when work must be redone



71% said costs related to employee downtime



58% said liquidated damages related to project delays
